Testing Opportunities

Miller Analogies Test (MAT)

The Miller Analogies Test is a graduate school admission test made up entirely of analogies, involving analytical reasoning as well as content knowledge. The MAT covers most of the general subject areas studied as an undergraduate (humanities, science, English), as well as subjects from everyday life. This test is offered on the USC Upstate campus throughout the year. This test may also be taken at other local institutions of higher learning.

Testing dates on our campus are listed below:

Test Dates:	October 19 November 16	March 21 May 16	July 25

Test administrators ask students to plan on a two hour time commitment in order to complete the necessary documentation and to take the test. The test consists of 120 questions to be completed in 60 minutes.

The following documentation is required the day of testing:

- \$75 Fee paid by check or money order payable to USC Upstate
- Photo identification
- Two number 2 pencils
- Name and mailing address of institutions where scores are to be sent (up to 3 at no charge)
- If MAT has been taken previously, prior score report *is required* for admission to testing.

Graduate Record Exam (GRE)

The Graduate Record Exam measures verbal reasoning, quantitative reasoning, critical thinking, and analytical writing skills that have been acquired over a long period of time and that are not related to any specific field of study.
