

# Shuttle Rules

- Present your University I.D. to the driver as you board the shuttle.
- Priority seating is available at the front of the shuttle to senior citizens and persons with disabilities.
- Service animals for the hearing and visually impaired are allowed on the shuttle.
- Radios, CD players, and MP3 players must be turned off while riding the shuttle unless you have headphones.
- Eating, drinking, and smoking are NOT allowed on the shuttle (bottled water is permitted).
- Chewing gum should be disposed of before boarding the shuttle.
- Excluding purses, all bags should be placed in the overhead storage areas or at your feet. No bags are allowed in the center aisle.
- Keep your feet on the floor and off the seats.

## How it works

There are three shuttle stops on the Main USC Upstate campus:

1. North Campus Boulevard and Hodge Drive.
2. University Readiness Center Front Entrance
3. Gramling Dr. (in front of Campus Edge Apartments).

Arrive at the shuttle stop at least five minutes before the shuttle is scheduled to depart. There is no fare for riding the shuttle; however, you must **show your student/faculty I.D. card to the driver**. Your University I.D. acts as your shuttle pass.

Please utilize overhead storage compartments to store backpacks during the ride. **No bags are allowed in the center aisle.** All emergency exits must be kept clear.

If you have any physical difficulties boarding the shuttle, or if you require the use of a wheelchair, inform the driver and he or she will assist you.

The Lost and Found is located at the USC Upstate Department of Public Safety building at 219 North Campus Boulevard.
