**Position Title:** Youth in Government Mock Trial Coordinator

**Number of interns needed per semester:** 1

**Major Objective(s):** Coordinate state-wide model legislature Model Appeals Court program

**Duties and Responsibilities:** Intern will research and locate (via internet and work with local attorney) case for 2006 Youth in Government Trial and Appeals Court programs. Research will include finding and selecting a trial case; working with local attorney to modify case to fit South Carolina YMCA Youth in Government needs; researching and writing appeals court cases; working with local attorney to select cases used for appeals court cases. Work will also include printing and putting together Attorney Handbooks once material is selected and created.
