Browsing the Collection

Physical Education & Training – For books about Physical Education and Training browse the shelves in call numbers GV 201- GV 555 in both the regular collection and the Curriculum Lab or try a subject search in the catalog using the term Physical Education and Training. For books on Coaching Sports browse the general collection GV 561 to GV 1199. Sports are subdivided into categories like water sports, ball games, and track & field athletics. You may also try a subject search using the term Coaching (Athletics) or use the subdivision training or coaching under individual sports (i.e. *soccer--training* or *baseball--coaching*) to retrieve books in specific sports coaching/training.

Recreation & Leisure – For books about Recreation and Leisure browse the shelves in call numbers GV 1- GV 1860, or try a subject search in the catalog using the term recreation or leisure, for example.

Periodicals – Periodicals to browse include: *American Journal of Health Education* or *Journal of Teaching in Physical Education: JTPE*. (Look in the online catalog for other journal titles by subject searching using the term physical education and training – study and teaching – periodicals).

Other Sources are in both the Reference and Circulating collections. For books on Dance browse the general collection GV 1580 to GV 1799. Also a subject search using the term dance or a subject search for specific types of dancing using terms such as ballet, folk dancing, or modern dance retrieves books about dancing or specific dances.

Databases & Web Pages

Academic Search Premier – Designed specifically for academic institutions, it is the world's largest scholarly, multi-disciplinary full text database containing full text for nearly 4,700 publications, including more than 3,600 peer-reviewed publications. In addition to the full text, this database offers indexing and abstracts for all 8,172 journals in the collection. This scholarly collection offers information in nearly every area of academic study including education.

ERIC (Via EBSCOhost) – A national education database sponsored by the Institute of Education Sciences of the U.S. Dept. of Education (via EBSCO Host) produces the world's premier database of journal and non-journal education literature. ERIC provides a public Web site for searching nearly 1.2 million citations going back to 1966 and, with contributor permission, accessing more than 110,000 full-text materials at no charge.

Education Full Text – Provides full text access to over 600 leading periodicals for students, teachers, professors, and college administrators. Encompasses all areas of concern to today's educators, including administration, teaching methods, and curriculum. (via WilsonWeb)

InfoTrac OneFile – Full text access to over 3100 titles in news, business, law, health care, education and current events from all over the world. Also includes newspaper indexes. (via DISCUS)

NetLibrary – provides access to the library's collection of e-books; available 24 hours a day. Collection includes many education titles.

Physical Education Index (print title) – REF GV201 .P534 vols. 1985-2000. Indexes periodicals in dance, physical education, recreation, sports, sports medicine, and training. BenOak Publishing Company.

Physical Education Index – feature a wide variety of content, ranging from physical education curricula, to sports medicine, to dance. 1970 to present.

Professional Development Collection – provides a highly specialized collection of electronic information especially for professional educators. This collection offers information on everything from children's health and development to cutting-edge pedagogical theory and practice. (via EBSCO host)
