[InfoTrac OneFile](#) – Available through DISCUS – is a comprehensive periodical database covering all subjects and all types of periodicals. It has over 22 million full-text articles on all subjects from over 5000 periodical titles including articles from newswires and general, professional, scholarly and children's periodicals.

[PsycARTICLES](#) – Available through EBSCOhost – provides full-text articles on current issues in psychology from respected sources, spanning from 1987 to the present. It includes more than 34,000 full-text articles from 43 journals published by American Psychological Association and allied organizations.

[Psychology and Behavioral Sciences Collection](#) – Available through EBSCOhost – provides coverage of nearly 550 full-text journals, including more than 500 peer-reviewed titles. It covers topics such as emotional and behavioral characteristics, psychiatry & psychology, mental processes, anthropology, and observational and experimental methods.

[PsycINFO](#) – Available through EBSCOhost – covers the professional and academic literature in psychology and related disciplines including medicine, psychiatry, nursing, sociology, education, pharmacology, physiology, linguistics, and other areas.

[ScienceDirect](#) – provides desktop access to the full-text of over 800 journals published or distributed by Elsevier Science. Coverage is strongest for biology, chemistry, geology, marine science, mathematics, medicine and physics, but numerous other disciplines are represented, including business, child development, computer science, economics, history, hospitality, industrial technology, library and information science and tourism.
