
Dear Spartans,

As we close the semester, Health Services is here to help you finish safely. To offer flexibility, and timely testing when you need it most, Health Services will be offering free COVID-19 testing appointments daily for the next three weeks, April 26 – May 14, in place of previously scheduled group clinics.

- Please call Health Services at (864) 503-5191 or go online to [www.uscupstate.edu/myhealth](http://www.uscupstate.edu/myhealth) to schedule your **free, same-day result**, drive-up test.
- The test utilized at Health Services for asymptomatic screening is the lower nasal test, collected by a nurse.
- Please call if you are a residential student without transportation and need COVID-19 testing at the Rampey Center. All other appointments will take place at the drive-up station at the Primary Care clinic, 995 University Way.
- We will continue to provide daily testing, medical care, and contact tracing for COVID-19 symptoms. Please call and speak with a nurse if you have any symptoms prior to testing.
- You may also utilize Spartanburg Regional's Drive-Up Testing Center at 1035 N. Church St. without appointment, open Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 9 a.m. – 4 p.m.

We also encourage you to get vaccinated, and upload your proof of COVID-19 vaccination to [www.uscupstate.edu/myhealth](http://www.uscupstate.edu/myhealth) as soon as possible. If you meet with others face-to-face, we encourage you to do so at a distance, masked, and outdoors. If you are not fully vaccinated, and have not had COVID-19 in the last 90 days, we encourage you to get a test.
