

Frequently Asked Questions

- **Can I use my health insurance to get my immunizations?**
 - Yes. Most insurance companies cover immunizations, but we would encourage you to call them to verify. If they do, you can go to any pharmacy to have that administered and they can bill your insurance directly. They will give you documentation that needs to be provided to Health Services.

- **I don't have health insurance, where can I get my immunizations?**
 - If your health insurance doesn't cover immunizations, please contact Health Services at (864) 503-5191 for an appointment. Cash pricing for required vaccines noted below.
 - Tdap: \$50
 - MCV4: (Meningitis Vaccine) \$115
 - MMR titers: (blood work to prove immunity) \$50
 - MMR vaccine: \$85
 - If you are 18 years old or younger, you may qualify for a federal program called VFC (Vaccines for Children.) Please make an appointment with Health Services to see if you qualify. If you qualify for VFC, each immunization may be as little as \$10.

- **I have a medical or personal reason that I decline vaccines, what do I need to do?**
 - We encourage all students who are medically able to get vaccines, and make this very affordable with our VFC program for those who qualify. All vaccine declinations are done by appointment only.
