


# Adobe Creative Cloud: Account Setup

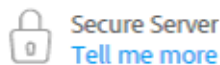
## First Time Users:

1. First time Adobe CC subscribers will need to have an Adobe ID generated by University Technology Services. Upon obtaining this ID, an email will be sent to the email address on file, titled “*Invitation to participate in the University of South Carolina deployment of Adobe Software*”. A link in the email will bring you to a registration screen similar to the image shown below. Please enter: First Name, Last Name, Email address (typically @mailbox.sc.edu), and a password to complete the sign-up process.

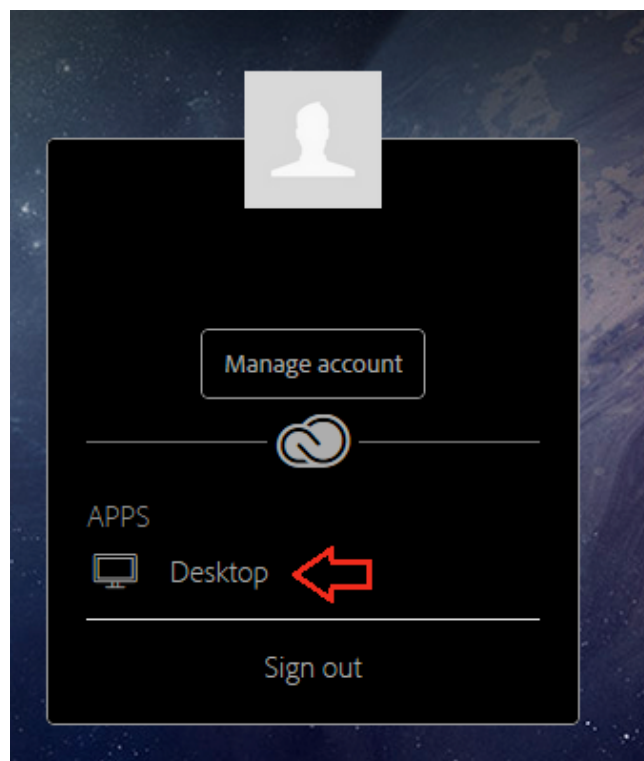

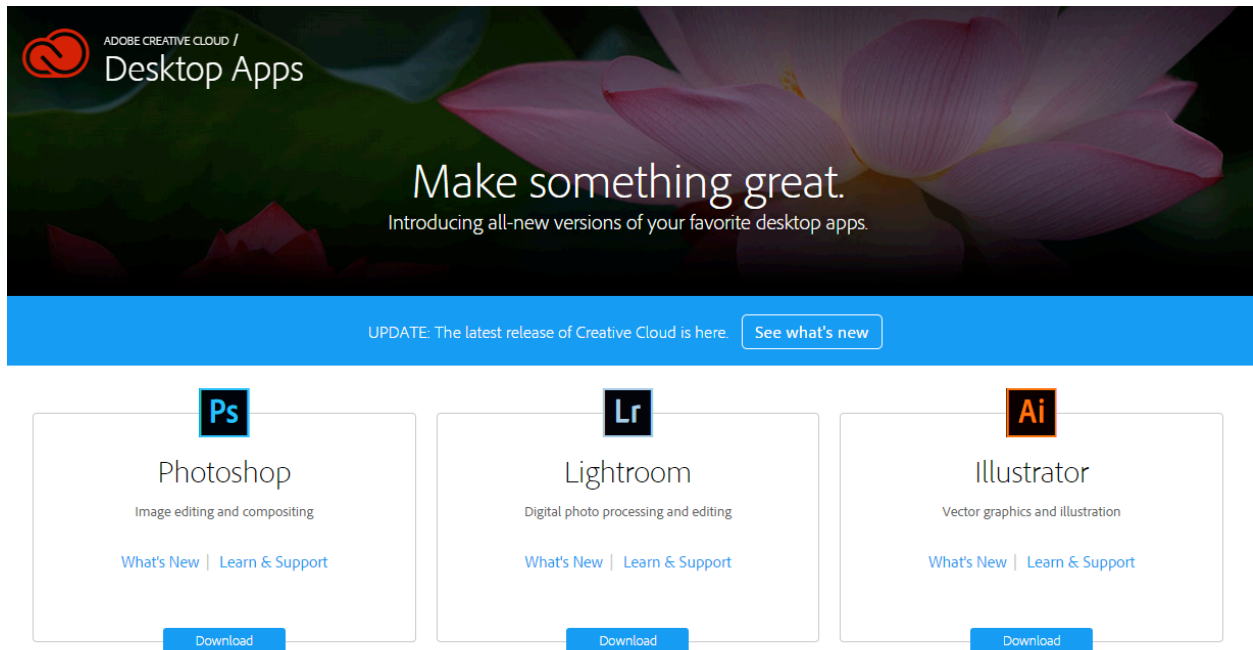
