Tuberculosis (TB) Test Requirement**

In response to school district requirements to allow teacher candidates into PK-12 school classrooms, current documentation of a “clear” TB test is required (in addition to the SLED check and Sex Offender Registry clearance).

All students applying to the Professional Program and all students entering into any clinical course, including EDSC 342 for ML/SEC Education majors, must have a TB test completed annually (once every 12 months).

As a convenience, USC Upstate Health Services has agreed to provide this test to students for a reduced fee. Students may opt to use this service or use a family physician. If a student uses a family physician, official documentation from the health provider must be submitted.

Students not having current documentation (within 12 months), will NOT be admitted into the Professional Program and/or allowed to complete a clinical placement until this requirement is met.
