The committee approved *two* catalog changes:

Chemistry requested a change to the Academic Regulations Section which allowed for course switches from Chemistry 101 to 106 or 111 in during the first two weeks of class because it puts students behind.

Honors deleted all references to the Honors “program,” made the process of graduating with honors more flexible, and cleaned up typos.

The Committee approved *two* new minors in the School of Education: Physical Education, and a minor in Education with will enable students who are in other majors but have an interest in teaching to receive a systematic educational experience.
