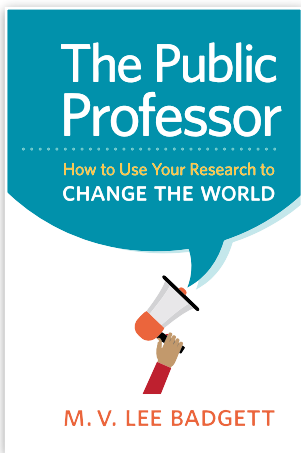
In this workshop participants will:
